

## Construction Notice

October 2015

### Summary


During the month of October, construction crews will continue preparing sites for the installation of toll system sign foundations. The work includes the demolition of existing median barriers, laying conduit and installing electrical systems along the corridor. The construction activity for the installation of electrical systems will occur on both the freeway and city streets.

### Purpose

Construction crews will install the toll sign foundations and signs once the median barriers are demolished. Once installed, the electrical systems will provide the power for the toll system signs.

### What to Expect

- Intermittent nightly closures are scheduled on I-680 in the northbound and southbound #1 and #2 lanes (lanes closest to the median). Construction crews are permitted to work on these lanes between the hours of 8 p.m. through 5 a.m., Monday through Friday.
- Construction crews will be present on some city streets in Dublin and Walnut Creek near I-680.
- Temporary and minor pedestrian detours may occur on city streets to maintain public safety.
- Temporary k-rail, construction signage and orange plastic fencing will remain along the corridor to maintain a safe work zone.
- Construction lighting will be present and directed away from residential areas.
