

## Construction Notice September 2015

### Summary

During the first half of September, construction crews will be preparing sites for the installation of toll system sign foundations. Intermittent nightly closures are scheduled on I-680 between Rudgear Road and Alcosta Blvd in the northbound and southbound #1 and #2 lanes (lanes closest to the median) through the month of September 2015 and will continue into the fall. Construction crews are permitted to work on these lanes between the hours of 8 p.m. through 5 a.m., Monday through Friday.

### Purpose

Construction crews need to remove sections of the median barriers on I-680 where toll system signs will be installed. Crews will install the sign foundations and signs once the barriers are demolished.

### What to Expect

- You may hear some noise from the demolition work.
- Construction lighting will be present and directed away from residential areas.
- Temporary concrete barriers, called k-rail, will be placed in the highway to maintain a safe work zone.
- Construction signage and orange plastic fencing to protect environmentally sensitive or landscaped areas is being installed throughout the corridor.
