
EASTBOUND DETOUR TO BEGIN MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND



Bay Bridge motorists should expect a slight alignment change as they approach Oakland

EASTBOUND DETOUR

Connecting the detour will not require a full-bridge closure. On Saturday, May 28 and Sunday, May 29, select eastbound lanes will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.; eastbound traffic will still be able to cross the bridge. Westbound traffic will not be affected. The speed limit will remain the same and will be enforced.



WHAT'S AHEAD

A westbound detour will be completed in early 2012. By implementing these detours near the Toll Plaza for the next two years, the entire bridge will open to the public earlier than previously scheduled. The detours will allow construction crews to work between the existing and new bridges to complete the new span's eastbound lanes, which is not possible without the traffic realignment.


