Caitlyn Fox focuses on policy at the Chan Zuckerberg Initiative, a philanthropic initiative founded by Priscilla Chan and Mark Zuckerberg with the aim to “advance human potential and promote equality in areas such as health, education, scientific research, and energy.” She also served as Chief of Staff there prior to her current role.

Ms. Fox was also a Leadership Fellow and the Director of The Wharton Social Venture Fund. Prior to attending Wharton, she worked for the Rockefeller Foundation, where she focused on strategic planning to identify and develop new areas of work for the foundation. Previously, Ms. Fox worked in management consulting for Booz & Company and Katzenbach Partners, serving technology and financial services clients on corporate strategy.
