

Eddie H. Ahn has served on the Commission since June 2020 representing the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission.

Commissioner Ahn serves as the executive director for Brightline Defense, an environmental justice nonprofit based in San Francisco. Prior to being a nonprofit attorney, he was an AmeriCorps member, serving as an afterschool programmer in Oakland's Chinatown. While working toward his law degree, he continued to teach art and public speaking workshops for youth and worked on civil justice and environmental issues for the Assembly Judiciary Committee in Sacramento.

In 2017, Eddie was appointed by Mayor Ed Lee to the SF Commission on the Environment, which sets policy for the SF Department of Environment and advises the City and County on environmental matters. In 2018, he was appointed by Assembly Speaker Anthony Rendon to the SF Bay Conservation and Development Commission (BCDC), a state planning and regulatory agency with regional authority over the Bay Area. He has also served on multiple nonprofit boards, ranging from Asian Pacific Environmental Network (APEN) to Mission Housing Development Corporation.

Eddie has received his J.D. from University of California, Hastings College of the Law and his B.A. from Brown University. He is also a member of the California State Bar.
