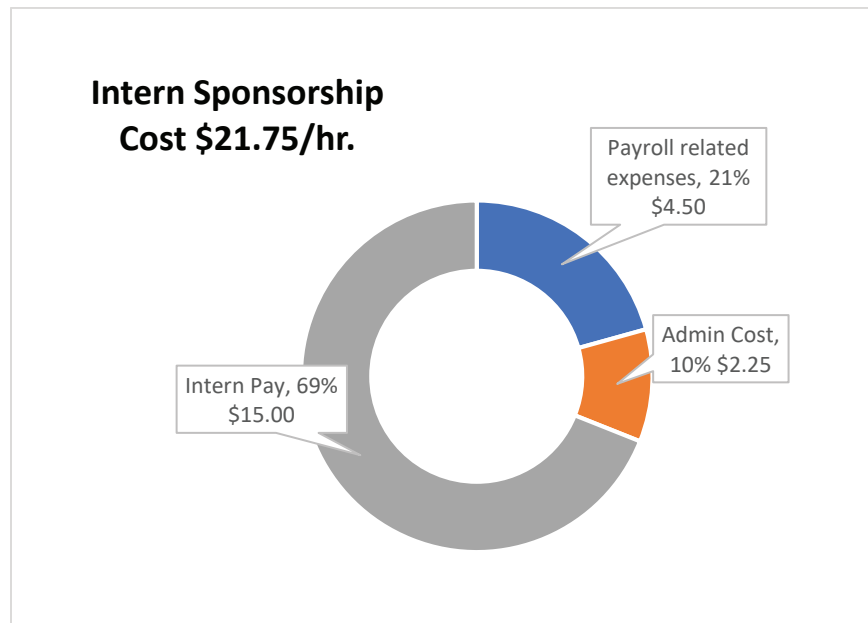


ESTIMATED COST FOR A HIGH SCHOOL INTERN

Thank you for your interest in the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) High School Summer Internship Program. Generally, MTC is able to fund approximately 30 internships throughout the nine counties of the San Francisco Bay Area: Alameda, Contra Costa, Marin, Napa, San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Solano and Sonoma counties. Intern salaries are paid by MTC. There is no direct cost to your agency unless your agency elects to hire an additional intern.

Every year, interest in our program increases and some agency requests may not be filled. However, we do guarantee one MTC-funded intern to agencies who use their own financial resources to sponsor additional student interns.

If your agency is interested in sponsoring a high school student (or two), the estimated cost is outlined below.



Approximate Cost for a 250-hour internship is \$5,437.50 - This covers the intern's salary (\$15.00/hr.), payroll related expenses (\$4.50/hr.) and administrative costs (\$2.25/hr.) including general liability and workers' compensation insurance.

Approximate Cost for internship events is \$261 - Orientation and Intern Forum average about 5 - 6 hours per event.
