### Designated Areas

State of California Preliminary Criteria:

1. Median family incomes of no more than 80% of statewide median income or metropolitan area family income (Top 30% of eligible tracts)
2. Tracts with at least 30 business establishments
3. At least 2 tracts per county to increase geographic diversity

State of California Final Criteria:

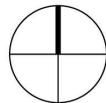
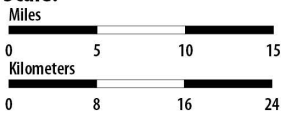
4. Limit selection to only those tracts that have a median income below \$100,000
5. Accept recommendations of local cities and counties to swap preliminary designations for alternative tracts.
6. Remove 183 tracts that received negative comments
7. The selected tracts are heavily consistent with the designation of the Legislature and Governor for disadvantaged communities for Cap and Trade purposes.
8. Designate those tracts that were specifically requested to the extent feasible.

### Eligible Areas

Federal Criteria\*:

1. ACS 2010 - 2014 Census tracts with poverty rates above 20% or;
  2. Median family incomes of no more than 80% of statewide or metropolitan area family income
- \*State added additional tracts based on ACS 2012 - 2016 data
