¹ Increased utilization of online reporting options by many jurisdictions in 2009 allowed MTC to collect and tabulate 2009 pavement condition data, even as 2008 data was still being compiled. To simplify reporting, MTC has decided not to separately report 2008 data, electing instead to bring all PCI data up to date as of 2009. The reported 2009 three-year moving average is computed from the individual-year scores for 2006, 2007 and 2009.

² This is the first year of reporting by Palo Alto. No average was computed.

³ PCI has been correlated from an alternative condition scale to the PCI scale.

* Three-year moving average score is an estimate based on inspections done in 2007.

** Three-year moving average score is an estimate based on inspections done in 2006 or earlier.
