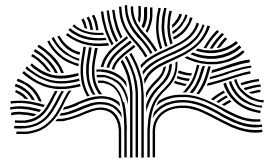

Following a two-year planning process, Oakland's speed cameras went live in January 2026

- 2024: Selected camera locations, performed stakeholder outreach, drafted system use and impact report, issued a competitive RFP
- June 2025 – received City Council approval to negotiate and enter into a contract with Verra Mobility
- October-December 2025 – completed camera design, permitting, signage and installation
- January 14, 2026: Program launch with 60-day warning period at all 18 locations (35 cameras), maximum allowable under AB 645
- March 15, 2026: Citation live at all 18 locations (35 cameras)



Camera Location Selection Process

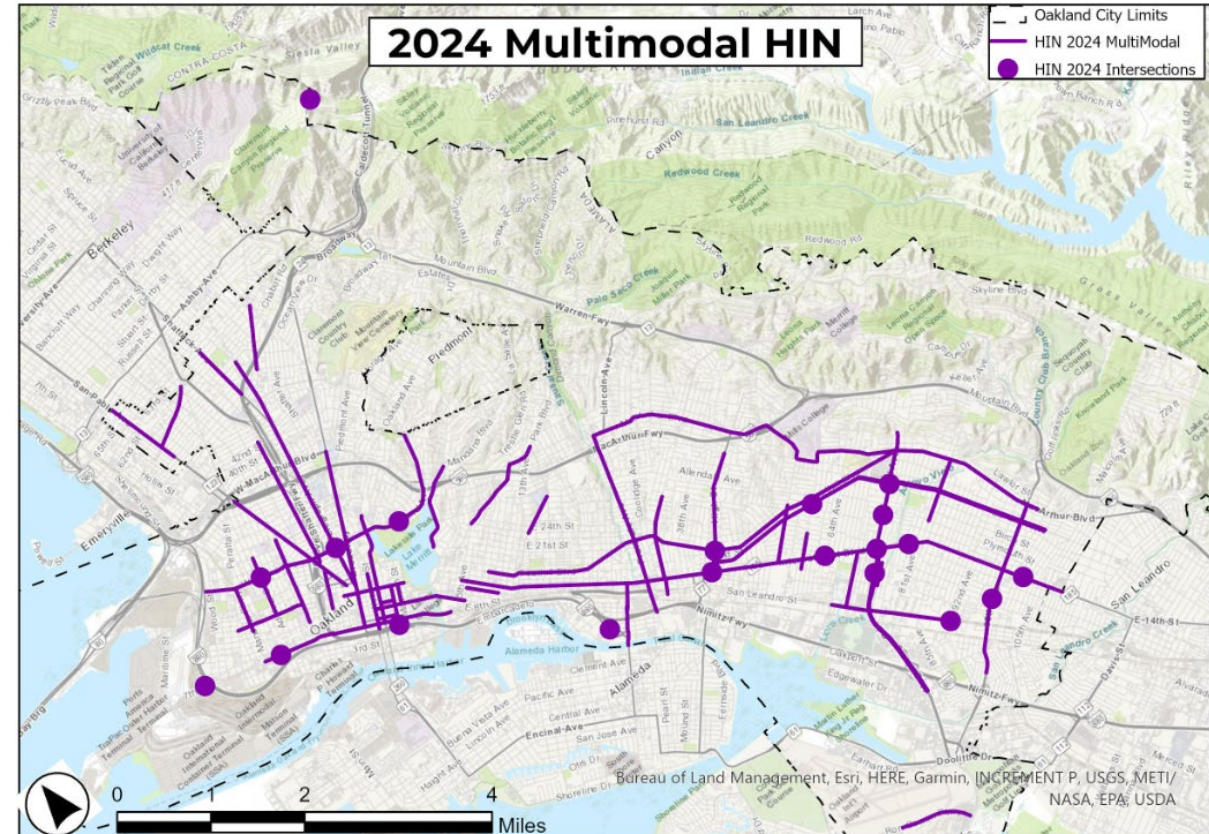
Bill Text required that camera locations be:

- Geographically Diverse
- On a “Safety Corridor,” a school zone, or a corridor with persistent “speed contests”

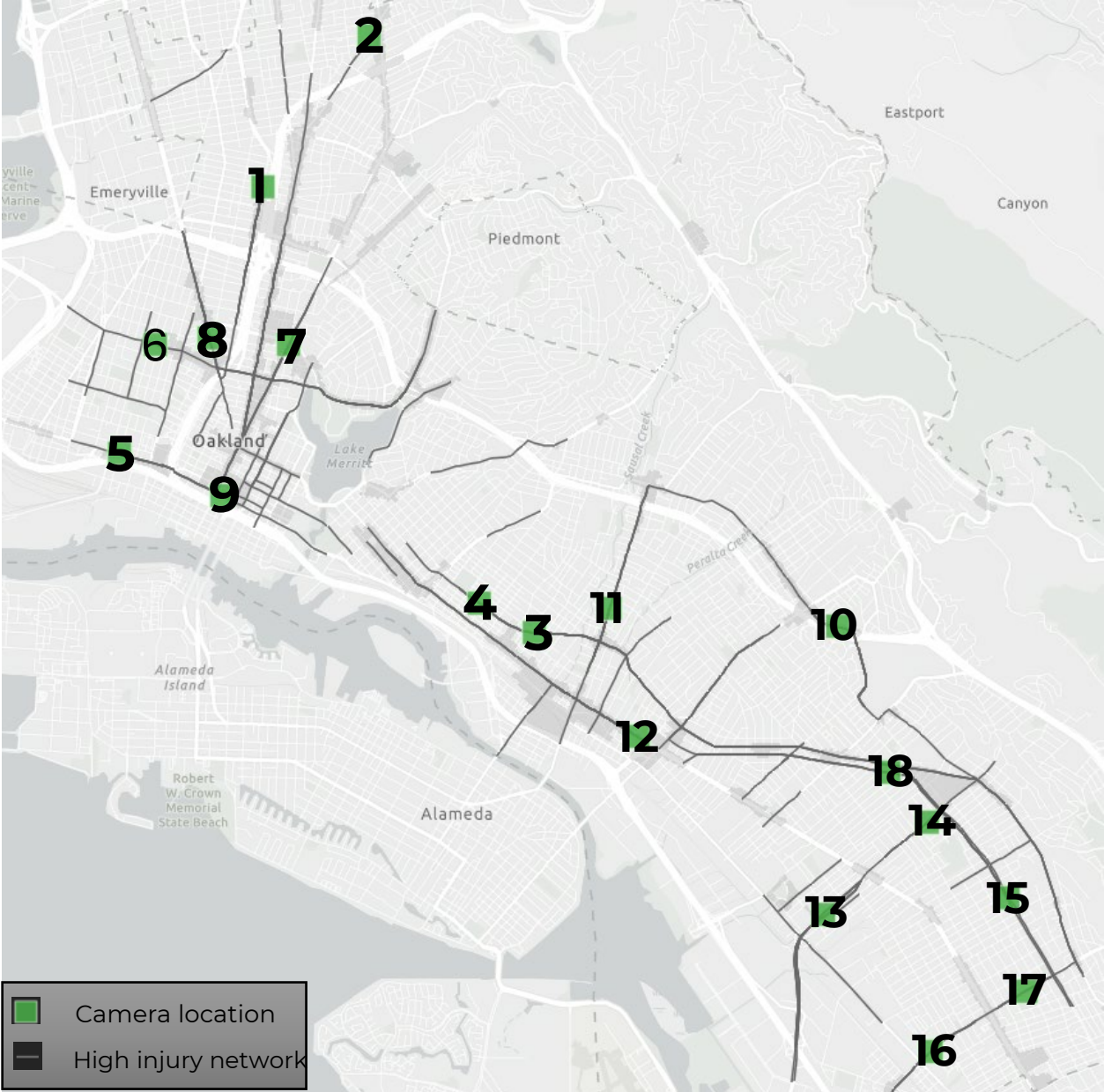
Took the 40 highest-injury blocks in the city, did speed studies at each. Of the segments with high injury crashes and high observed speeding, we selected from them based on severity and sensitive land uses.

With Caveats:

- Put one in each District (geo. diversity)
- Avoid putting two in proximity along the same corridor (to not double-cite)

Initial Report – 1/14/26-2/21/26

- Cameras issued 140,445 warnings — roughly 100 per camera per day on average.
- Out of 140,445 warnings, 66% went to drivers who had two or more warnings.
- Based on camera data, the average speed of all traffic is close to the posted speed limit at all locations. In other words, most drivers are generally driving close to the speed limit.

One-time plates: 47,581 plates (64.4% of all plates) generated 47,581 warnings (33.9% of all warnings).

Repeat plates (2 warnings or more): 26,268 plates (35.6%) generated 92,864 warnings (66.1% of all warnings).

Oakland will continue tracking this data to determine the impact of citations on influencing driving behavior.

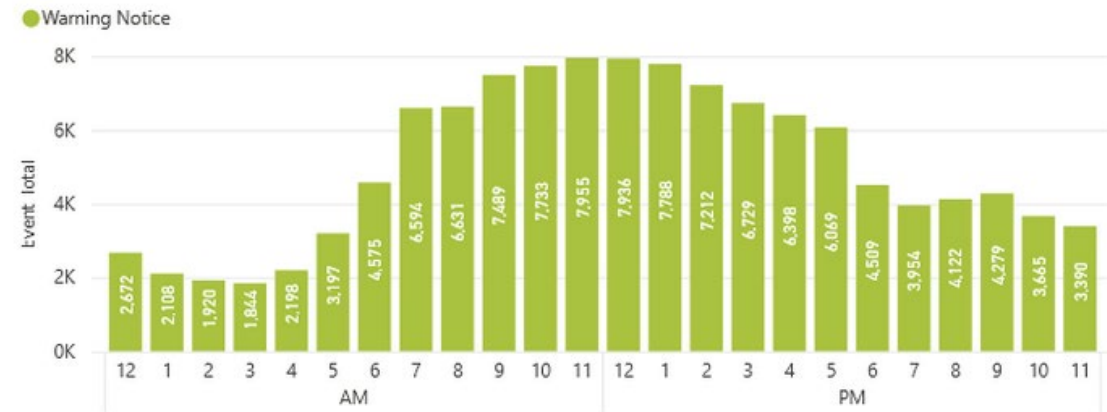
Initial Report – 1/14/26-2/21/26

Cameras with Most Warnings

Speed camera locations were chosen using the [High-Injury Network \(HIN\)](#) — the 6% of Oakland’s streets that account for 60% of severe and fatal collisions in Oakland. The 18 camera locations were prioritized based on observed speeding and proximity to sensitive land uses such as schools, senior centers and commercial districts. The ten cameras with the most warnings are:

- 73rd between Fresno & Krause, SB (320 avg. per day)
- Broadway between 27th/28th St, NB (296 avg. per day)
- Broadway between 27th/28th St, SB (243 avg. per day)
- Hegenberger Road between Spencer & Hawley, SB (225 avg. per day)
- 98th Avenue from Blake Drive to Gould Street, SB (221 avg. per day)
- 7th Street from Adeline to Linden St (WB) (200 avg. per day)
- West Grand Avenue from Chestnut to Linden Street (WB) (198 avg. per day)
- Hegenberger Road between Spencer & Hawley (NB) (175 avg. per day)
- San Pablo from Athens Ave to Sycamore St (SB) (131 avg. per day)
- 98th Avenue from Blake Drive to Gould Street (NB) (137 avg. per day)

Preliminary Data from Post-Citation Live (3/15-4/25)

- Issued ~82,000 citations and 69,000 warnings from 3/15-4/25
 - Average 60 citations per camera per day and 50 warnings per day
- Top locations remain consistent with initial report
- Currently focused on customer service including processing community service/fine reduction requests, protests, transferring liability for sold/rental cars, etc.
- Next report to be issued mid-July, which will include before/after speed data
