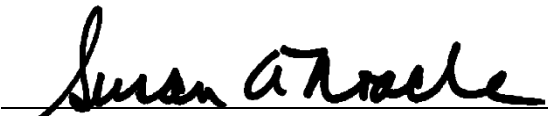

The business to be transacted will include: (1) Call to Order / Roll Call / Confirm Quorum; (2) Chair’s Report; (3) Closed Session; (3a) Closed Session Public Comment; (3b) CONFERENCE WITH LEGAL COUNSEL-ANTICIPATED LITIGATION. Initiation of litigation pursuant to paragraph (4) of subdivision (d) of Section 54956.9: (One case: Cubic Transportation Systems, Inc.). The Commission shall meet in closed session to consider initiation of litigation under Section 54956.9 of the Government Code.; (4) Open Session; (4a) Report of Closed Session; (4b) Next-Generation Clipper Update.
