Resolution No. 3575 ? Golden Gate Transit?s request for an allocation of \$232,717 in STA Regional Express Bus funds for operating support for two express bus routes.*

a) Golden Gate Transit is requesting regional operating subsidies for two express bus routes. One of these routes has been modified from the original route proposed in the Regional Express Bus program.

 b) MTC Resolution No. 3515 established policy for programming the FY 2003-04 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 funds, which provided flexibility to program funds for preventive maintenance. The policy was intended to mitigate budget shortfalls caused by the prolonged recession. Some operators continue to experience economic hardships, and this action provides preventive maintenance funding in FY 2004-05 to three such agencies.
