 3. The Bay Bridge Forward project, 9a, will receive OBAG 2 funds from the RTC project (Action 25a) and the RTC Project will be allocated \$500,000 in Blue Ribbon funds.

 4. Clipper BayPass Phase 1 programming covers the initial two years of the program (August 2022 to August 2024).

 5. These funds will support staff work related to Fare Coordination/Integration Study implementation, Mapping and Wayfinding project development, Transit Priority coordination, overall implementation of the

Action Plan, and Transit 2050+ (connected network planning).
6. BART's total Phase 1 (August 2022 to August 2024) Cliper BayPass reimbursemnt allocation totals \$4,332,098. Of this total, \$2,331,423 is STA Population-Based funds programmed through MTC Resolution 4519 (Blue Ribbon Transit Transformation Action Plan Program of Projects) while the remaining \$2,000,675 is to be fulfilled with FY 2024-25 STA Population-Based Regional Program funds programmed to Clipper BayPass via MTC Resolution 4642 and allocated via Programming and Allocations Committee action in September 2024.
