Council Member Kallins requested a report on the Marin/Sonoma County Transit Operator Coordination (MASCOTS) Program noting that the coordination among transit agencies could serve as a valuable model for other communities.

Council Member Hankerson requested an update on Highway 12.

Council Member Levin reported the Transit Transformation Task Force Meeting (https://calsta.ca.gov/

-/media/calsta-media/documents/tttf_meeting_10_agenda_v1-a11y.pdf) will be held on April 25, 2025 at the Bay Area Metro Center. The meeting agenda includes key topics such as funding needs and revenue generation, accessible transportation and the mobility needs of older adults, Transportation Development Act reform, and capital construction costs. Council Member Levin requested the Council leadership work with MTC leadership on these matters and consider incorporating them into the Council's future work plan, as appropriate.

Council Member Orantes reiterated a point first raised in January 2025, which was subsequently included in the February 2025 Staff Liaison Report, regarding the sanctuary status of transit operators. She expressed continued interest in learning whether any transit agencies in the region are actively addressing the impact of enforcement actions on immigrant communities. Specifically, Council Member Orantes requested an update on any policies or practices that have been identified in response to this issue, as a follow-up had previously been indicated. Additionally, Council Member Orantes voiced support for Council Member Kallins' comments on the MASCOTS Program and expressed interest in highlighting local efforts that, while not regional in scope, demonstrate positive, impactful approaches that could inform broader strategies.
